NEW STALLHOLDERS 2018

Thank you for your enquiry regarding becoming a stallholder at the Barmera Main Street Market.

We have enclosed forms and the conditions of the market for you to complete. We would appreciate it if the completed form and money could be returned at least five working days prior to the market date to the address on the forms. (*Barmera Main Street Market, Barwell Avenue BARMERA SA 5345*) This then allows us time to complete our paperwork prior to the actual market.

Please note payment is required prior to the Market and a 20% discount is offered if payment is made in advance for the whole year's markets (2018 - 8 markets)

If you are selling any food items you must be able to provide a Food Business Notification Number (obtained from your local Council). If you are unsure if you have already notified, contact your local Council. **Food must not be sold unless you can provide a food business notification number.**

Once we have received your application we do not have any further contact with you until the morning of the market.

As is stated in the Conditions of the market, setting up time is between 7am and 8.30am. As the main street is closed to vehicular traffic on market days, all cars (not being used as part of the stall) need to be out of the market area no later than 8.30am.

On arrival at the market to set up, you are asked to come to our van, which is usually situated near the clock tower in the main street (Barwell Ave). We will provide you with a receipt for your money and will then show you to your site. Please be advised that unless you are a regular stallholder with a permanent site your site may move according to market needs – please with Market management at each Market.
